- There will be a consult/exam fee assessed for any issue not directly related to the surgeries for the day. The fee will be determined based on the time and complexity of the consultation.
 - Exam fee is not charged for follow up exams for surgical patients with complications (limited to complications from surgeries performed by another veterinarian at SNIP Society)
 - O I do not consult for patients with chronic conditions, illness, or injury owned by the general public. I recommend that these patients follow up with a full-service veterinary facility.
- Trip charge \$100
- Hourly charge for vaccine clinics \$125 per hour

Any atypical surgeries performed will be charged appropriately on a case-by-case basis and the cost determined at the time of surgeries. I am comfortable performing a wide range of soft tissue surgeries and some orthopedics. Examples include: Enucleations, mass removals, inguinal hernia repair, gastropexies, onychectomy, limb amputations, tail amputations, femoral head and neck ostectomy (If proper surgical equipment is provided), emergency procedures, and other surgeries. Please note that anesthesia and analgesia plans may need to be altered for these other surgeries in order to mitigate risks and provide adequate pain management.

I do not typically charge for the occasional minor non-surgical procedure (ie. Catheter placement, blood draws, microchipping, nail trimming, etc...). If these types of procedures become a regular need and inhibit my ability to perform surgeries, an appropriate charge will be determined and applied.

If I need to officially maintain medical records and controlled substance records, I will charge for this because it requires a lot of time. Otherwise, I can dictate surgical abnormalities or make notes on the cards and the notes can be added to the animal's medical record by someone else.
