Covert: Loaves and Fishes presentation, DuDot road improvements in District 5, Member Initiative Program.

Eckhoff: Animal Services ribbon cutting, Crisis Recovery Center preview/ribbon cutting.

Childress: Member Initiative Program.

Pruyn: Building and development, fireworks cancellation, Only in Itasca grants, data center construction, park improvements, President's Cup and Haymarket litigation.
