8. ADMINISTRATIVE UPDATE

Laura shared current animal population stats: current population is 248, of which 181 are cats. Cats continue to present space challenges. Animal Services will be targeting spay/neuter resources at cats to help reduce unwanted litters and slow the flow of cats into the shelter system.

Requests for owner relinquishment continue to come in, as do the number of cats found outdoors. The most common reason for cat relinquishment is financial hardship, often combined with other personal circumstances.

Staff are discussing ways of getting supplies and medical care resources into the community but the problem is so pervasive and growing so quickly that need is far out-pacing available resources.

Intake has been significant so far this year. 1,848 animals were admitted in all of 2024. Intake for 2025 year to date is already above 2,200 animals. The majority arrived as strays from the public or municipal partners. 846 are owner relinquished animals.

Animal Services hosted a very successful free vaccine/microchip clinic on September 8th. Lines were so long that several clients had to be turned away at the end of the night with a voucher to be redeemed for free vaccines/microchip at a later date. More than 180 animals were vaccinated and microchipped during the event on Sept. 8th with another 25 event vouchers redeemed post event.

10. FY2026 ANIMAL SERVICES BUDGET PRESENTATION

Laura presented the FY2026 Animal Services budget to the committee.

Key takeaways:

- Animal intake for 2024 was 1,970 despite efforts to limit intake due to construction
- Live Release Rate increased to 94%
- Animal Control Officers conducted 1,325 animal investigations and completed 348 field calls
- 1,629 animals received community outreach medical services
- DCAS is prioritizing community services and education outreach for FY2026, including the soft launch of veterinary clinic services and on-site programming
- Animal Services will complete a reorganization in FY2026 which will include the addition of supervisory positions that will allow supervisors to step out of the day-to-day and manage their teams, while providing the support needed to meet increasing demand for services in a bigger shelter. Veterinary positions are being added to support the launch of veterinary clinic services.
- Once reorganization is completed, Animal Services will be comprised of 28 full-time, 4 part-time, and 3 seasonal staff members.
- No increase in registration fees is anticipated at this time.
- Final construction expenses are expected to be paid in FY26 once HVAC issues are resolved. County Facilities, the general contractor and engineers are working toward resolution.
- DuPage Animal Friends will continue to provide Animal Services with a \$50K annual unrestricted grant.

11. ADMINISTRATIVE UPDATE

Laura shared that demand for owner pet relinquishment is high and the availability of assistance for pets owners in need of relinquishing their pets in other counties is very low to nonexistent.

Animal Services will participate in Clear the Shelter by offering fee-waived adoptions for adult dogs and cats for the week of August 23rd - 30th. Puppy and kitten adoption fees will be half off during the same timeframe.



Action Requested - Identify the action to be taken and the total cost; for instance, approval of new contract, renew contract, increase contract, etc.

Extend contract to November 30, 2026. No change in contract amount.

Summary Explanation/Background - Provide an executive summary of the action. Explain why it is necessary and what is to be accomplished.

This agreement with RWE Design Build is for Professional Construction Manager at-risk, for the Animal Services Facility Addition and space renovation. The project is substantially complete with an occupancy permit. A contract extension is requested to complete outstanding construction matters.

Original Source Selection/Vetting Information - Describe method used to select source.

A request for two Statements of Interest were issued one for Professional Architectural and Engineering Services and one for Professional Construction Manager At Risk (G-MAX) services for the Animal Services Facility Addition; three Architectural and Engineering firms and three Construction Management firms were interviewed, RWE Design Build was determined to possess the qualified staff to provide these Professional Construction Manager Services. Knight E/A, Inc. was selected to provide the Architectural and Engineering Services as a sub-consultant to RWE Design Build.

Recommendations/Alternatives - Describe staff recommendation and provide justification. Identify at least 2 other options to accomplish this request.

- 1) Staff recommends approval to extend the contract to November 30, 2026 due to project delays of the Animal Services Facility Addition.
- 2) Not resolve final construction matters.

WHEREAS, the County of DuPage heretofore accepted and appropriated the DuPage Animal Friends Unrestricted PY25 Grant, pursuant to Resolution FI-R-0042-25 for the period December 1, 2024 through November 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the County of DuPage has invested cash balances in accordance with the DuPage Animal Friends grant requirements and has interest income earned in the amount \$1,470.67 (ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY AND 67/100 DOLLARS) during the term of the award, to be used for the support of the DuPage County Animal Friends Unrestricted PY25 Grant; and

WHEREAS, no additional County funds are required to appropriate this interest earned; and

WHEREAS, the DuPage County Board finds that the need to appropriate said interest creates an emergency within the meaning of the Counties Act, Budget Division, (55 ILCS 5/6-1003).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the DuPage County Board that the interest income earned in the amount \$1,470.67 (ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY AND 67/100 DOLLARS) be and is hereby accepted; and
