6.A. Presentation on Establishing the DuPage County Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program

Chair Covert introduced Anthony McPhearson, Chief Information Officer for DuPage County, who summarized the background and progress of the DuPage County Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program, its current status and future direction. He stated that the immediate goals are to obtain County Board approval to implement the program; then, provide educational outreach to our vendors about the DEB program and educate and train staff about their respective roles within the program; and, finally, to establish a Division of Contract Equity within DuPage County and hire a Contract Equity Administrator. Long-term goals are to continue to collect accurate data and provide dashboard reports, then ensure contract compliance after we develop our goals. Consistent updates will be provided to the Strategic Plan Committee and the County Board. The ultimate goal is to achieve contract parity. Mr. McPhearson noted that the program will sunset after six years. Following his presentation, Mr. McPhearson invited questions and comments from the Committee.

Nick Kottmeyer noted that an expanded presentation will go before the County Board and Finance Committee at their May 28 meetings. With their approval, a resolution to authorize implementation of the DEB Program will then be drafted for the Strategic Planning Committee at its June meeting.

No new business was discussed.

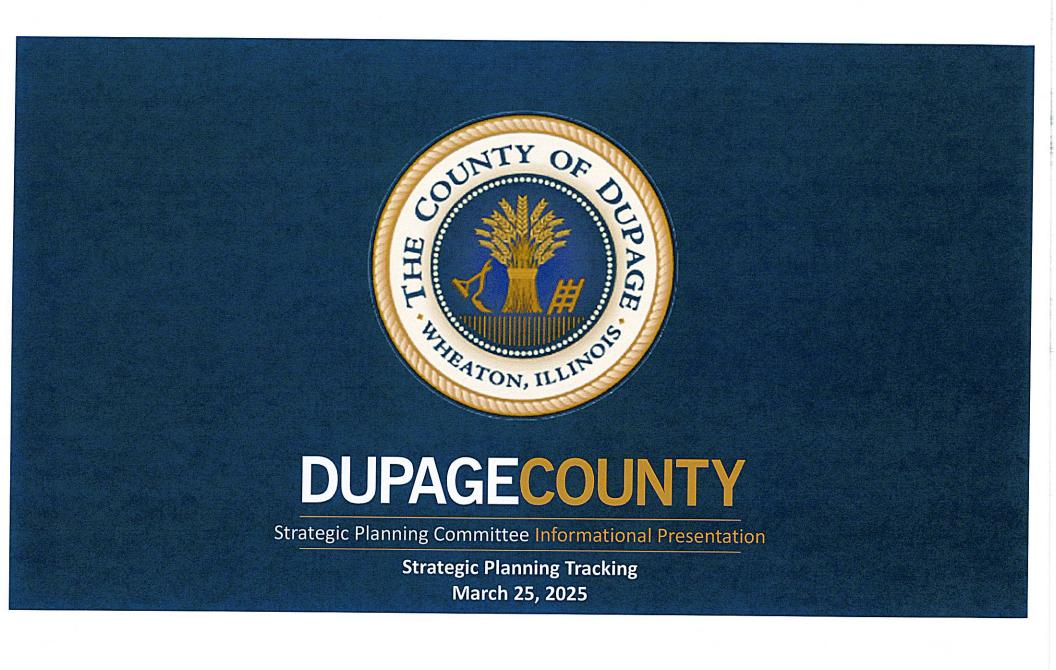

- FY 25 Budget had strategic goals, and we will work with Departments to ensure they are meeting the stated goals in line with our Strategic Plan



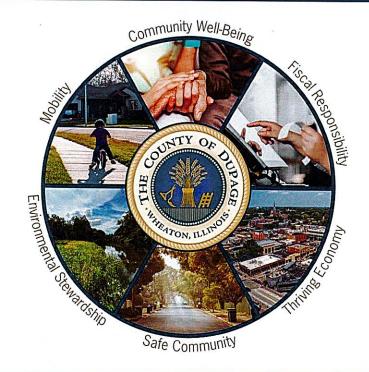
