Township Survey



Mailed survey to 20,236 unincorporated properties in Addison, Bloomingdale, Milton, Wayne, Winfield, and York Townships

Received 2,133 responses, a 10% response rate


Q6: If you answered "No" to question 4, what reason or reasons did you have for answering "No"?
