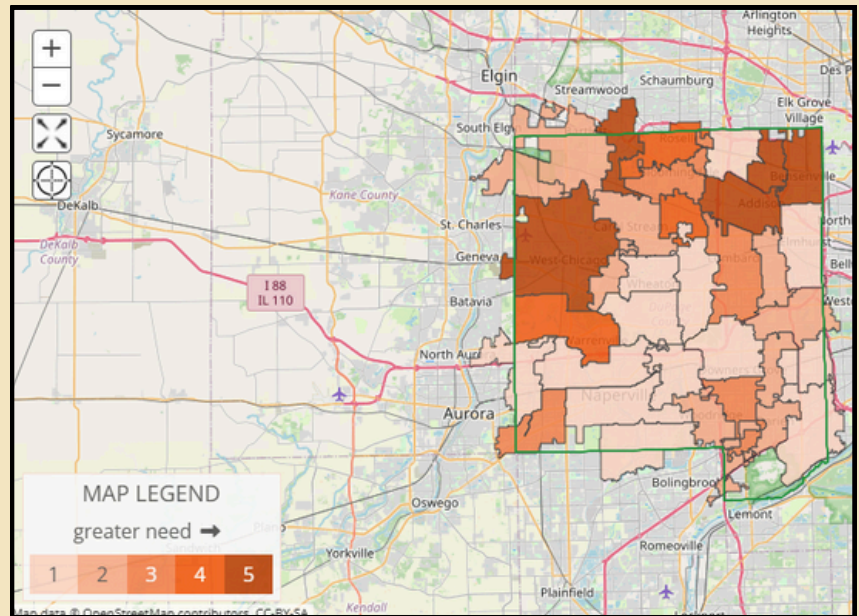


## 2024 Summary

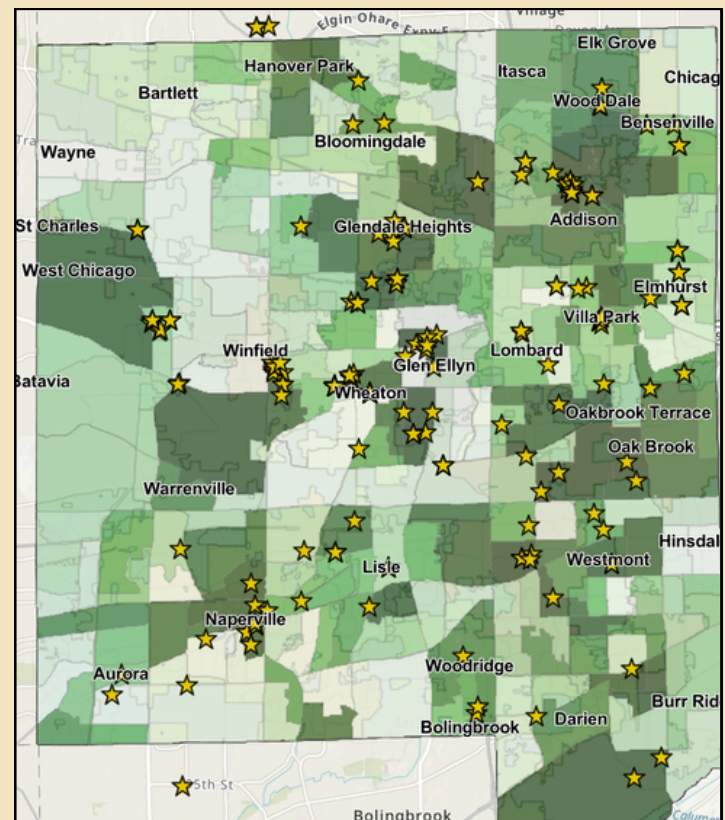
- Community Services attended a total of **164** events.
- Collaborated with **141** different organizations in DuPage County.
- Community Services shared information on our services with **6,812** people.
- Utilized the ***Impact DuPage Health Equity Index*** as a baseline for determining which areas are most in need.



The **HEI** measures socioeconomic needs in correlation with poor health outcomes (shorter life expectancy, infant mortality rates, and higher death rates for leading causes of death).

- Continuing to connect with County resources
- Material creation/drop off in high-trafficked areas
- Connect 7000 or more people with Community Services information
