DuPage County Environmental Division collaborated with the Metropolitan Mayor's Caucus, City of Chicago, and Cook County as well as Kane County for Climate Pollution Reduction Grant applications. U.S. EPA did not award any of these project applications however, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency is anticipated to receive \$430,251,378 for implementation of the State of Illinois' Priority Climate Action Plan.
