I don't think that this is an accurate representation of the county's many people who have made significant contributions. There are at least five outstanding women who deserve recognition: Comment: 1) Ava Dodge Blodgett (1796-1882) who ran an Underground Railroad Station in Downers Grove. 2) Glennette Tilly Turner (1933-) of Glen Ellyn, historian and author. She documented the underground railroad stations throughout Illinois and wrote

books about them for both adults and children.

- 3) Ellen Martin (1847-1916) attorney and suffragist who was the first woman in Illinois to cast a ballot. She voted in a local election in Lombard in 1891.
- 4) Lotte Holman O'Neil (1878-1967) of Downers Grove was the first woman to be elected to the Illinois State Assembly and a founding member of the League of Women Voters of Downers Grove.
- 5) Betty Cheever (1928-2021) was the first woman to become mayor of Downers Grove and served in that capacity from 1983-1999.

These are just a few of the outstanding Dupage County residents who were not white males.
