

RESOLUTION 2024-4493

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT OF EASEMENT TO DUPAGE COUNTY FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A SIDEWALK ALONG COLLEGE ROAD

WHEREAS, the County of DuPage (hereinafter referred to as COUNTY) proposes to construct sidewalk to fill in the sidewalk gap along College Road, Section No. 23-SDWLK-07-SW (hereinafter referred to as PROJECT); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Lisle (hereinafter referred to as VILLAGE) possess an easement for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a sidewalk along College Road recorded as Document No. R88-120466 on October 21, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE is empowered to assign its easement to the COUNTY upon a two-thirds vote of the VILLAGE'S Board pursuant to the authority conferred by the Local Government Property Transfer Act, 50 ILCS 605/0.01 *et seq.* (hereinafter "TRANSFER ACT"); and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and VILLAGE are municipalities as defined in Section 1 (c) of the TRANSFER ACT; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the Local Government Property Transfer Act, 50 ILCS 605/2, authorizes a municipality (VILLAGE), pursuant to a resolution passed by a two-thirds vote of the members of its corporate authority, to convey real estate to a municipality (COUNTY) when it is necessary or convenient for the municipality (COUNTY) to use, occupy or improve the real estate in the making of a public improvement or for a public purpose of the transferee municipality (COUNTY); and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has determined that temporary assignment of the easement, is necessary and required for this PROJECT and the COUNTY has, by Ordinance DT-O-0002-24, declared the need for said easement assignment; and

WHEREAS, the County and Village shall work collaboratively on said temporary assignment of easement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lisle, DuPage County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and Village Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and seal the Temporary Assignment of Easement (attached heretofore as Exhibit A).

FURTHER, be it resolved that this resolution shall be entered upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lisle.

The ASSIGNOR does hereby assign a non-exclusive right and interest in, and does authorize the use of, the following described easements by the ASSIGNEE for purposes of sidewalk construction and grading as part of the County of DuPage's project known as Section No. 23-SDWLK-07-SW:

10-foot Village of Lisle Easement as described on the Easement Agreement recorded as Document No. R88-120466 on October 21, 1988, and as further depicted in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The ASSIGNEE shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend the ASSIGNOR, its officials, officers, employees, and agents from and against all liability, claims, suits, demands, proceedings and action, including costs, fees and expense of defense, arising from, growing out of, or related to, any loss, damage, injury, death, or loss or damage to property resulting from, or connected with, the ASSIGNEE's negligent or willful acts, errors or omissions in its performance under this Assignment to the fullest extent permitted by law. The ASSIGNEE does not hereby waive any defenses or immunity available to it with respect to third parties.

This Agreement, made and entered into on <u>John 17,1988</u>, 1988, by and between Illinois Benedictine College (Grantor) and the Village of Lisle, an Illinois Municipal Corporation (Grantee).

That for and in consideration of ______ and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Grantor does hereby give and grant in perpetuity to the Grantee an easement, right, privilege, and authority to construct, own, operate, maintain, and repair a sidewalk in and upon the property legally described as:

Parcel #1

The north 1,115 feet of the west 12 feet of the east 62 feet of Parcel 1 of the Illinois Benedictine College Assessment Plat in Section 16, Township 38 North, Range 10 East, of the Third Principal Meridian, in DuPage County, Illinois, as recorded in Document No. R74-50004, in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of DuPage County, except that part previously dedicated.

It is further agreed as follows:

- 1. The Grantee agrees that it will save and hold the Grantor harmless from all claims, causes and actions, suits, damages or demands whatsoever in law or equity which may arise out of, or as a consequence of the negligence of the Grantee, or its authorized agents or employees, in constructing, operating, maintaining or repairing said sidewalk.
- 2. All rights, title, and privileges herein granted shall run with the land described above, and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, and their respective successors in title, heirs, executors, administrators, lessees and assigns.


