Winfield School District 34

April 1988 to May 1994

Mr. Reyes was a school board member at District 34 from 1989 to 1994. He served as President from 1990 to 1994. His board was instrumental in managing financial strength, adopting policies for inclusion of special needs students and hiring 2 Superintendents.

DuPage Airport Authority

June 1994 to September 1999

Mr. Reyes was appointed to the DuPage Authority in 1994 and served as Treasurer from 1994 to 1999. During those years the airport tax rate declined significantly throughout all years.

Community High School (CHS) District 94

April 2004 to April 2009

Mr. Reyes was the President of CHS D-94 school board from 2005 until 2009. Under his leadership the board balanced the budget by eliminating a \$1.4 million deficit, lowered the tax rate, made NCLB annual yearly progress goals, and redirected the educational

focus toward core curriculum, installed an artificial turf athletic field and hired a new Superintendent. At the end of his tenure as President D94 have \$8 million in reserve.

DuPage County Sheriff's Merit Commission

October 2003 to Present

Mr. Reyes is the Chairman of the DuPage County Sheriff's Merit Commission. Responsibilities include managing the budget and the certification of Deputy Sheriff's candidates through testing, assessment and multiple interviews. The Merit Commission also serves as an independent separate from the Sheriff's office and has the final word on all adjudication and mitigation for disciplinary matters brought before the commission.

Mr. Reyes was instrumental in setting a vision for growing sustainable new revenues streams. He served on the Finance and Administration committee, Traffic and Safety Committee and the Zoning Board of Appeals.
