Significant Variances:

\$75,000 in new program request to increase headcount by one Housing and Community Development Planner in anticipation of new initiatives coming from the Ad Hoc Committee on Housing Solutions. Other changes include 5% increase in salaries due to reduced offsets from CARES and ARPA grants, and supplies now charged to individual departments.
