MS. INFELISE: Sure. Originally when this came into our office as an application, it was for 16 or over children. After review after we sent this up to the department, the Health Department came back, notified us that on well and septic only 12 children can be present in a day care home. So we received in email from the petitioner on Friday, April 21st stating that he is no longer requesting the 10 to 20 children, he is requesting 10 to 12 children.

CHAIRMAN KARTHOLL: Okay, I think that's clarification enough.

So, I will also observe that there was no case made and, you know, it's a sensitive kind of a use which implicates safety of the children, so all of the details of drop-off and pick-up and outside activities and inside activities and food service, et cetera, none of that was developed, so I concur with Mr. Ketter.
